Purpose

This Privacy Policy outlines how Aria Community Health Center (ACHC) handles personal information collected through its website. It applies to all personal data created, received, maintained, or transmitted by or to the ACHC website.

Introduction

By using the ACHC website, you agree to the terms of this Privacy Policy. If you disagree, please refrain from using the website. Note that the website is hosted by a third-party service provider, which may access personal information as part of its hosting services.

Children's Personal Information

The website is intended for a general audience and is not directed at children under 17 years of age. As a non-profit organization, ACHC's collection of children's personal information is not governed by the U.S. Children's Privacy Protection Act ("COPPA").

Information We Collect

Information You Submit: We collect personal information you provide directly, such as when filling out forms, scheduling appointments, or making payments. This may include your name, contact details, health information, and payment details.

Information We Collect Automatically: We use tracking technologies to collect information about your interactions with the website, including usage details, device information, and geolocation data.

Website Permissions

Depending on your device settings, the website may access your location, storage, camera, microphone, and other device features. You can adjust these permissions through your device settings.

How We Use Your Information

We use your information to provide and improve our services, fulfill contractual obligations, notify you of changes, conduct research, and ensure security and compliance.

Disclosure of Your Information

We may share your information with subsidiaries, affiliates, service providers, and other third parties as necessary to operate our business and comply with legal requirements.
